

All About Performance Royalties



What are Performance Royalties?

Performance royalties are paid to the copyright holder. Composers and scriptwriters rely on royalties as their livelihood. Remittance from royalties ensures that these artists are able to keep creating great new works for schools and theatre groups. Purchase of the musical package from the publisher provides the school or theatre group with the materials required to rehearse and produce the musical.

Which performances attract a royalty fee?

All public performances attract a royalty fee. This includes any performance for an audience other than the performers themselves. It is illegal to perform a musical in a public forum without registration and payment of the required royalties to the copyright holder.

Are musicals covered by schools performing rights agreements with collection agencies such as APRA/AMCOS?

Musicals are considered Grand Rights Works under Copyright Law and are not covered by these agreements. Any performances, copying or filming can only proceed with permission from the copyright holder (ie RockED Music)

Permission and Registration Forms are included in the musical package.

Copyright

Any changes to the script or songs can only be made with the written permission of the copyright holder. Simply contact RockED Music with any enquiries regarding alterations. We are happy to discuss your requirements with you. Permission to copy scripts is included in the musical package.

Video Permission and Royalties

Permission is required from the copyright holder for any recording (video and/or audio). Royalties are payable for any sales arising from duplications of recordings on DVD or USB. Permission and Registration Forms are included in the musical package.
